Introduction


It is now one year since Jonathan Kuttab became Executive Director of Friends of Sabeel North America. During that time, Jonathan sought to build upon the excellent work of his predecessors and carry out the mission of FOSNA of being a Christian voice for justice in Palestine. Looking forward, we set out to achieve the following goals:

- Fortify, expand, and mobilize FOSNA's constituent base.
- Continue shining a light on the violent reality of Israeli apartheid and its catastrophic impact on Palestinian lives and communities.
- Declare and embody a prophetic message for the churches in America, confronting destructive ideologies and promoting theologies of liberation, justice, and peace.

The Team

Staff consists of Jesse Wheeler as Executive Administrator | Development Director; Rev. Chad Collins, long-time leader with Pittsburg Friends of Sabeel and the Israel-Palestine Mission Network, as FOSNA National Organizer; and Laila Abbas as Communications and Campus Outreach Coordinator. Previously, Laila served as Chapter President for Students for Justice in Palestine (SJP) at her university. Finally, Amy McLaughry continues her involvement as FOSNA's long-time bookkeeper, or "Chief Number Cruncher" as she likes to be called.

In addition, we were pleased with the addition of some amazing new members to the board of trustees, including Sabeel founder Naim Ateek as President Emeritus as well as Mary Segall, M. Theresa Basile, and Saleem Alhabash. Nahida Halaby Gordan has taken over as Co-Chair from Brian Grieves to serve alongside Co-Chair Joe Roos. Former board Treasurer




Paul Parker resigned from the Board of Trustees to accept a position in Ramallah, Palestine. FOSNA is actively seeking his replacement, being very intentional with regard to the establishment of a diverse and representative board in terms of race/ethnicity, gender, social, and ecumenical composition.

Campaigns, Activities, & Special Events

In the past year, FOSNA was able to organize, conduct, and/or participate in the following campaigns, activities, and special events:

- **#Justice4Halabi.** Palestinian prisoner and humanitarian Mohammed El-Halabi, former head of World Vision in Gaza, was wrongly imprisoned on false charges of redirecting millions of dollars of aid money for Gaza to Hamas. 3,277 total signatures were collected in support of Halabi and people were encouraged to contact the Israeli officials directly about their concerns.
- #StandWithThe6. FOSNA has also been bringing attention to Israel's spurious designation of six leading Palestinian humanitarian and human rights organizations as terrorist organizations. This campaign has included letter writing, intervention with the State Department and congressional offices, as well as sharing information and updates about the six organizations.
- Instagram Account Launch. FOSNA launched a new Instagram account.
- **New Website Launch**. Following a month of hard work, FOSNA was able to launch a new, updated website utilizing the Squarespace platform. This was a major accomplishment with regard to updating the public face of FOSNA.
- **Be Alert: Preach Palestine 2021.** Picking up on the momentum from 2020, FOSNA continued the Preach Palestine campaign for Advent 2021. A new Preach Palestine page was created for the website with new resources for the 2021 advent season. A spanish language page was also established.
- **A Declaration Regarding Respect for the Bodies of the Deceased**. Having gathered endorsements via petition from hundreds of religious leaders across the country, FOSNA




sought to bring attention to Israel's unethical and immoral treatment of deceased Palestinians. They delivered this signed petition to the Israeli Embassy in Washington DC, alongside Nonviolence International, and religious leaders from Jewish, Islamic, and Christian backgrounds, to demand the proper treatment and burial for detained Palestinian bodies. The declaration received 871 endorsements, with nearly 300 from Christian, Muslim, and Jewish religious leaders.

- **Naim Ateek Booklet Launch**. FOSNA was able to promote the launch of six new booklets from Sabeel founder Naim Ateek. In addition to participating in a launch event, a new page was established on the website for interested persons to purchase and download the booklets, or order physical copies from Sabeel Jerusalem.
- **Christians in Palestine Two Films.** FOSNA was proud to co-sponsor and help organize a film screening and discussion salon by our friends at Voices from the Holy Land. The films screened and discussed included:
 - Bethlehem: The Living Stones, and
 - Christians of Palestine: Life Behind the Wall
- Sabeel Memorial Service for Archbishop Desmond Tutu. Sabeel and Friends of Sabeel held an online memorial service for Archbishop Desmond Tutu, long-time patron of Sabeel International. Jonathan served as master of ceremonies. While spearheaded by Omar from Sabeel Jerusalem, the FOSNA team (staff and board) was involved throughout the planning process. Hundreds attended and the event was recorded and appears on our Youtube and website.
- **#JourneyWithJonathan.** For the month of February, Jonathan Kuttab traveled to Palestine, meeting with and learning from as many as possible about the current realities on the ground, while sharing daily updates and reflections about his travels via social media. He also regularly presented his recent book *Beyond The Two-State Solution*, recently translated to Arabic and Hebrew.
- The Other End of the Sea: A Conversation with Author Alison Glick. Jonathan Kuttab interviewed the author Alison Glick with regard to her recent novel *The Other End of the Sea*, a tremendous novel about which Mondoweiss declares: "The depth of




understanding that this book demonstrates for the Palestinian experience over the last four decades is astounding."

- *Easter in Jerusalem: Holy Saturday Service*. FOSNA and Sabeel Jerusalem joined up to host the annual Easter in Jerusalem service. The service was led by Rev. Naim Ateek with assistance from long-time Sabeel friends.
- Jerusalem Christian Committee: Freedom to Worship Campaign. Together with Sabeel Jerusalem and key leaders like Bishop Mounib Younan and Don Wagner, FOSNA joined together in an ad-hoc committee to address a series of issues directly affecting the Palestinian Christian communities, including the harsh restrictions placed on Easter worship at the Church of the Ressurection, settler takeover of church properties in East Jerusalem, the murder of Shireen Abu Akleh, and what was President Biden's forthcoming trip to the Middle East. Actions associated with this campaign included:
 - Promoting a petition by Sabeel Jerusalem in support of the freedom to worship for Holy Land Christians
 - An article describing the unacceptable situation as it concerns freedom of worship in Jerusalem, for both Christians and Muslims
 - Presenting to select members of congress a join-letter composed by a broad coalition of leading grassroots Palestinian Christian organizations.
 - FOSNA also composed a letter and received endorsements for a letter to President Biden and the US State Department.
 - Jonathan Kuttab composed and sent a direct letter to Archbishop Dr. Hosam Naoum Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem and the Middle East.
 - Finally, FOSNA intentionally sought to highlight and promote those actions initiated by allied organizations that focused on the freedom of worship, a demand for action in response to the death of Shireen Abu Akleh and others, and those sent in advance of Biden's trip to the Middle East.



- **FIFA: Suspend Apartheid Israel.** With the 2022 World Cup just around the corner, FOSNA and Just Peace Advocate launched together a campaign to highlight the fact that FIFA is violating its own rules in its acceptance of Israeli crimes against the Palestinians. The campaign, which is ongoing, has featured:
 - Collecting the endorsement of a multitude of organizations in support of the campaign
 - Collecting the signatures of many individuals in support of the campaign
 - A webinar featuring representatives from Palestine, the Palestinian Football Association, musician/activist Roger Waters, and Jonathan Kuttab
 - A letter writing campaign to FIFA leadership demanding action
 - Building an international coalition and coordinating between international groups and individuals to stop "friendly games" between Israeli and other international teams
 - Currently, the focus is on helping the Bolivian team understand why they should cancel their match, as happened recently with Argentina.
 - An endorsed letter sent and a letter-writing campaign directed to the Union of European Football Associations
 - More actions to come . . .
- **#StandWithStephen**. Rev. Stephen Sizer faced a Church of England tribunal in response to his advocacy for Palestinian rights. FOSNA launched a mini-campaign asking our constituents to send Rev. Sizer messages of encouragement during this difficult time.
- **#Justice4Halabi Briefing.** FOSNA hosted a briefing on the conviction of Muhammad Halabi. Halabi's lawyer, Maher Hanna, joined us to explain the situation as fully as possible, enabling us to know how to best proceed in our support of #Justice4Halabi.



We were also joined by Halabi's father, Khalil, who has been a tireless advocate on behalf of his son over the past six years.

- A Dossier on Israeli Apartheid (published by Kairos Palesetine and Global Kairos for Justice. FOSNA members were happy to assist in the development of a new dossier from Kairos Palestine and Global Kairos for Justice, a "study for Christians and other civil society organizations who want to learn more about the crime of apartheid and why Palestinians and a growing number of churches and human rights organizations are using the word to describe Israel's oppression of Palestinians."
- Theology, Liberation, & Palestine: Conversations in Honor of Rosemary Radford Ruether. We were joined by Naim Ateek, Marc Ellis, Nora Carmi, Kathy Bergen, and more in a webinar conversation on the past, present, and future of liberation theology in the context of Palestine/Israel, in dialogue with and honor of the life and work of Rosemary Radford Ruether. On top of being one of the most important theologians of recent memory, Rosemary was a dear friend and deeply important to FOSNA and the global Sabeel movement as a whole.
- *Witness and Solidarity Trips to the Holy Land.* FOSNA is now actively planning trips to the holy land through Sabeel Jerusalem and our many friends on the ground. Stay tuned for additional details.

Articles, Statements, and Reflections

Over the course of the past year, FOSNA has published the following articles, statements, and reflections. As we began, we were averaging an open rate of approximately 30%. However, this percentage rose fairly quickly to a rate around or above 40% of our approximately 25,000 email subscribers. Rebuilding Alliance set up at least 90 meetings with congressional offices to discuss Israel's unfortunate labeling of top human rights groups as "having ties with terrorist organizations." Jonathan Kuttab met with at least eight senators or representatives, brought in to serve as an expert on the topic, while Jesse Wheeler utilized the FOSNA database to send out targeted announcements and invitations for FOSNA members to attend such meetings with their own representatives. Recurring Gatherings & Meetings

The following gatherings or meetings occur on a weekly, monthly, or semi-regular basis (excluding ongoing staff, board, committee, or specific event planning meetings and interviews):

- In March, FOSNA reinstituted the administration of monthly gatherings for **Denominational/PIN Leadership**. While administered by FOSNA, the gathering is envisioned as being by and for all members of the group. We meet together online every fourth Monday of the month. This recently led to the discussion of forming topical working groups.
- FOSNA has been involved in planning stages of the **Apartheid Free Congregations** campaign, alongside our friends at the American Friends Service Committee, BDS, and other denominational leaders/allies. The campaign has yet to launch, but regular steering team meetings are underway.
- FOSNA members regularly attend the monthly **BDS Grassroots Campaigning Check-In.**
- We also attend the regular **No-IHRA** international network gatherings to challenge the abuse of the IHRA definition of antisemitism to silence Palestinian advocacy .
- Meetings of the Christian Zionism Geopolitical Working Group.
- In addition to being regularly involved in the weekly Sabeel Prayer Service and the Kumi Now online gatherings, FOSNA has instituted weekly meetings with Omar Haramy who is the director of Sabeel Jerusalem.
- Finally, Jonathan Kuttab is also a board member and active participant of the Palestinian Christian Alliance for Peace (PCAP), as well as an active member of the Mennonite Palestine Israel Network (MennoPIN) steering committee.

Partnership Building


As a result of the global pandemic, there has been a need to jumpstart various groups and programs. As such, FOSNA staff have been reaching out to the leadership of FOSNA's local affiliate groups as well as other groups with whom FOSNA has had close relationships.
